

## Q&A for Little League Day 2026

This year's game is on **Sunday, April 26<sup>th</sup>, at 1:35pm** against the Boston Red Sox.

Tickets are **\$15** each, plus Credit Card fee.

Tickets are purchased through the link on our website and through emails sent throughout the program.

Anyone that wants to watch the parade and attend the game will need a ticket to get into Camden Yards.

This is open to as many peoples as you would like to bring (**Walking on the field is only for Coaches and players**).

Once tickets have sold out, or we have closed sales on a certain date, tickets will then be divided up. We sit all teams and kids together, along with any family that comes along with them.

Before the day of the game, the Orioles will email us telling us where to meet up. This is organized chaos (lol). They set up colored balloons at home plate plaza (directions will follow).

We also confirm with all coaches that someone will be there from each team to walk with the kids. If we have a team that doesn't have coaches going, we will set you up with another coach to walk with. This will be confirmed before the event takes place.

It is highly recommended to show up early from the announced time as there is multiple rec programs like ours that will be there.

When you get to our colored balloon and find your coach, please sign your child's name on his ticket (not on bar code) and give it to coach. This way after the parade, coach will get everyone into the stadium and up to our seats. We are all grouped together so this should really be a smooth process.

After your child is with the coach, they ask parents to leave the home plaza area. They do let you in early to get a good spot to watch the parade.

When the parade starts and we get close to the field, please have your kids lined up together and coaches on the right. This way kids can hi five players that are in the dugout and coaches can keep kids in track area (they will not allow us on the grass).

Once around the track and back outside, please enter any ticket gate you like.

Again, teams are assigned to sit together so it shouldn't be hateful getting everyone back to their family and seats.
