Our Baseball Program has in-house leagues for ages 4 through 15 and Travel teams where try-outs are required, for ages 7 through 19.

Please read through the league descriptions and feel free to email us if you have any questions. Each participant is provided with a uniform consisting of pants, shirt and hat. The uniforms are Major League Replica T-Shirts and Hats and are yours to keep and will be handed out by your team manager during team practices in April.

We do celebrate Little League Day at Camden Yards. This is where the coaches and players get to walk around the field at Camden Yards. Date and time will be released once confirmed by the O's.

**You will be contacted by your coach no later than Sunday March 23<sup>rd</sup> with the time and date of your first practice. If you are not notified by Sunday, please email us at [wmbaseball410@gmail.com](mailto:wmbaseball410@gmail.com). It takes time to secure coaches and to form teams, please be patient as notifications may come anytime up to March 24<sup>th</sup>.**

Regular team practices will begin at designated baseball fields **starting on Tuesday April 1<sup>st</sup>**. The coaches will have schedules to designate when and where each practice will be held.

The In-House Baseball season is scheduled to end on or around Saturday June 14<sup>th</sup> (depending on weather). Some age groups may play into the week of June 17<sup>th</sup>. All In-House Baseball will end prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **In-House Evaluations**

The players in the following leagues will be required to attend an evaluation: Little League. This is done to form teams as evenly as possible. You will be contacted via a Stone Alley email for evaluation day and time slot. This normally occurs in March. Keep in mind that any requests received for these leagues are likely not to be granted due to the draft process.
